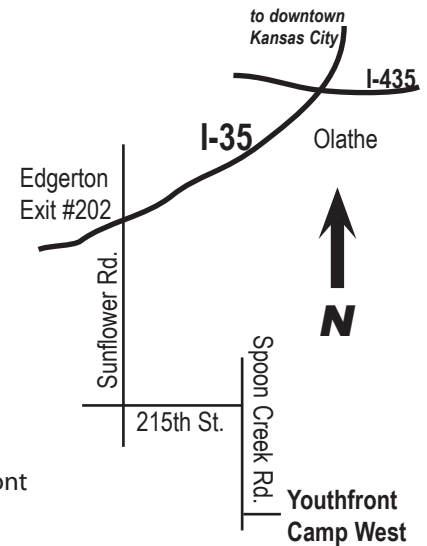


Information For Your Week at Youthfront Camp West

Directions To Youthfront Camp West

Go southwest out of Kansas City on I-35 to Edgerton exit (exit 202). Turn left (south) and go approximately 1/2 mile on Sunflower Road. Turn left (east) on 215th Street; go one mile. Turn right (south) on Spoon Creek Road; go 1/4 mile, then turn left into the Youthfront Camp West entrance. Watch for the signs.



Arrival

Registration at Youthfront Camp West begins on Monday at 1:00 p.m. Report to the **Dining Hall** to pay the balance due, turn in waivers and get your cabin assignment. All campers need to be settled into their cabins by 2:00 p.m.

Departure

Please plan on attending our Parents' Continental Breakfast at 9:30 a.m. on Saturday. We will let you know how your child's week has gone, hold a drawing for gift certificates for Camp 2010, and relay other helpful information. You must pick up your child at Youthfront Camp West between 10:30 and 11:00 a.m. Saturday.

Clothing

We suggest all clothing and other belongings be marked with first and last names. Although our staff will do their best to locate any belongings, we are not responsible for lost items. Lost and found items will be returned at your expense. ALL unclaimed items will be donated to charity after four weeks.

Casual dress is appropriate. Bring old clothing for special outdoor activities and paintball. Jeans or long pants and closed-toe shoes are necessary for ATVs. Remember ATVs are only available to campers 12 years and older.

Modest length shorts are acceptable. Loose-fitting clothing **MUST** be worn over any Spandex outfits. **MODEST** swimsuits are a must! A dark T-shirt must be worn over swimsuits when at the waterslide or the Blob for both safety and modesty.

GIRLS: No white or two-piece swimsuits except for tankinis that cover the midriff. Bring a coverall to wear over swimsuits to and from the pool or waterslide. At the Blob, a dark T-shirt and shorts are required over swimsuits. **PLEASE**, no mini-skirts, crop-tops, or see-through blouses. Appropriate undergarments **MUST** be worn at all times. Modesty is the key guideline.

Things to Bring

- Toothbrush and toothpaste, comb, soap, shampoo, washcloth, towel, deodorant, razor, etc.
- All medications (except for emergency use) must be kept in the camp Infirmary and taken as scheduled.
- Bible, pen or pencil.
- Bedroll (sheets, pillow and pillow case, sleeping bag, blanket or bedspread for a twin-size bed) only the bed and mattress are provided.
- Optional items such as softball glove, fishing equipment, inexpensive camera, etc.

Things Not to Bring

Directions To Youthfront Camp West

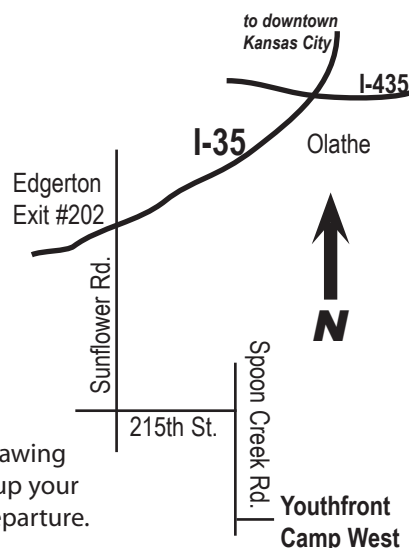

Information For Your Week at Youthfront Camp South

Directions to Youthfront Camp South

Southbound on Hwy 69: Continue south of 151st Street approximately 31 miles to the 399th Street exit. Turn right (west) and go 4/10 of a mile to Jingo Road. Turn left (south) and go 2 miles to 2400 Road. (Watch your speed! Limits change from 55 to 40.) Turn left (east) and go 7/10 of a mile to the first camp entrance on your left.

Northbound on Hwy 69: Exit at 152 Highway/ E. 2200 Road. Turn right (east) and go 2/10 mile to Valley Road. Turn left (north) and go 2 miles to E. 2400 Road. Turn left (west) and go 4/10 mile to the second camp entrance on your right (main entrance).

Arrival

Registration begins at Youthfront Camp South on Monday at 1:00 p.m. Report to the Chapel to pay the balance due, turn in all waivers, and get your cabin assignment. All campers need to be settled into their cabins by 2:00 p.m.

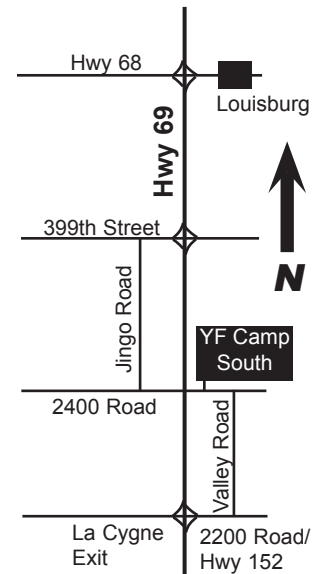
